



## MAINTENANCE AND CARE

- Cleaning removes dirt and stains to maintain the aesthetic appearance of the coating. Documented cleaning is required at 6-months intervals. The frequency of cleaning must be increased in more aggressive environments and climate conditions. Remove ordinary dirt and stains using a mild and non-abrasive household neutral detergent (pH 5 to 8) diluted with water. Do not use dish soap. In addition, the cleaning agent should not contain abrasive materials or solvents as these might have an adverse effect on the coating. Cleaning of the powder coated finish shall be conducted out of direct sunlight and the surface temperature of substrates shall not exceed 86°F.

Household towels made of cotton or polyester are simply too abrasive to be safely used on your fence paint coating. A microfiber drying towel is softer and more absorbent, which will protect your finish and get the drying job done much faster.
